

**To be added to the NARCOTIC ADMINISTRATION PROTOCOL (page 78) under letter C and inserted as point #5 (points #6-8 will be renumbered accordingly)**

5. In the stable pediatric patient, who requires pain therapy for moderate-to-severe pain, and who does not have IV access, consider **intranasal Fentanyl**.
  - a. Use IV fentanyl, 50mcg/mL concentration, with Mucosal Atomization Device (MAD) on syringe.
  - b. **Dosage:** IN fentanyl 1.5mcg/kg, to maximum of 100mcg (2mL) divided evenly between nares, rapidly infuse through MAD to each side.
  - c. May repeat dosage of IN fentanyl q 5 minutes to a **maximum of 200 mcg**.
  - d. **Note: There will be 0.1mL of medication left in the MAD after administration so be sure to add 0.1ml extra medication or add a small amount of air to push medication through the MAD.**
