


Okanogan/N. Douglas County EMS TCC Injury Prevention MOU Report

June 2014

The Injury Prevention MOU was granted to supply the council's technicians with tools necessary to insure children are in safe, appropriate child passenger safety seats at the conclusion of a car seat installation check. The funds are being used to support the purchase of child passenger safety seats and educational materials.

Since March, technicians have conducted 18 seat installations/checks and distributed 10 new child passenger safety seats replacing those in use that were expired or no longer appropriate for the child. County technicians (7) provided a car seat check event in Omak followed by CEU training for technicians hosted by the WSP office. Each technician was able to complete seat checks for re-certification and earn 3 continuing education credits toward re-certification. Car seats will be purchased to replace those distributed to date and at future seat check events. PSA's for child passenger safety have been published on Facebook (Aero Methow) and have been recorded for KCSY Sunny FM. Child Passenger Safety educational materials are being purchased for future public education events. A car seat check event in north Okanogan County is currently being planned for August. Interest in technician training has been expressed by north county EMS providers. Your support of the child passenger safety technician's serving Okanogan County allows us to continue to provide a valuable injury prevention program in our respective communities.
