Ped safety presentation to 30 Washington School students and each student received a Clifford the big red dog walk safely book

Community safety booth at Pybus market for Home Fire drill day, educated on the importance of having an escape plan and practicing it, 911 education and child passenger safety education- 65 adults, 38 children visited our booth

Wenatchee, Okanogan, Bridgeport, Mansfield, Liberty Bell and Pateros High school all participated in a Distracted Driving event at their school...students signed pledge banners to not drive distracted, they heard distracted driving messages over the intercom, they were given items with a distracted driving message on them (Lanyard, water bottles or notebooks) and was put in a drawing for \$136.00 amazon card which would be the cost of a ticket if you were cited for driving distracted. Pledge banners were hung in the school after the event.
